

35 South Summit Street

Records indicate a modest structure on this land as early as 1842. A decade later, the dwelling was enlarged and possibly faced east. Note in lower righthand picture taken from the present rear, Jan. 9 1968, the roof of the addition in front of the gabled second story, is nearly flat and unlike any of the other roofs.

Lower left, Nov. 26 1967, shows the modest porte cochere. Upper left full front, Jan. 9 1968, looks much the same as the 1892 picture of the house in the Souvenir booklet of Ypsilanti. Upper right, Mar. 7 1967, shows the long veranda across the front on the west side of the house.
